

Rhetorical Analysis

- This project will be very similar to the presentations you did for the Deford Commentary.

You need to pick a text of your choice. (Be sure to review notes about “text” we discussed earlier in the year.) Text can be anything that provides a message. (Book cover, video game cover, movie, TV Show, TED TALKS..If you are unsure, email your teacher for clarification.)

You must create a visual aid to use during your presentation. The presentation must include each of the following sections. You will not write an essay, but rather your speech will be analyzed as an essay.

- 1) Explain the context of the text
 - a. Use P.A.S.T.A
 - i. Purpose, Audience, Subject, Tone, Author or Authorial Bias.
- 2) The text or excerpt of the text.
 - a. If you are using a movie, TV Show, or longer TEXT must find at least 3 instances to discuss.
- 3) Rhetorical Analysis of the text
 - a. Should have a few notes or comments, but most of this will be given as part of the presentation when showing the text.
