

Centennial PTSA Car Raffle Official Rules & Regulations

Centennial PTSA Car Raffle (“Raffle”) is a fundraising activity conducted by the Centennial PTSA in support of the Centennial High School Band. These Official Rules & Regulations (“Rules”) govern the conduct of the Raffle and together with the decisions of the Centennial PTSA (“Board”) are binding on everyone who purchases a Raffle ticket and/or who is named on a Raffle ticket. These Rules may not be waived, modified or supplemented except by the Board in writing. These Rules apply to any and all individuals selling Raffle tickets and anyone in PTSA.

TICKET COST AND ODDS OF WINNING: The ticket price is \$20.00 per ticket, 3 tickets for \$50 or 7 tickets for \$100. A maximum of 5,000 tickets will be sold. Ticket sales will cease if the maximum number of qualified entries is reached. Any requests and payments received following the cut off time or after the sale of 5,000 tickets will be returned to the sender. The odds of winning the Grand Prize as well as the Early Bird Prize will depend on the number of eligible entries received and accepted by the stated cutoffs for each respective drawing. However, the odds of winning will never be greater than 5,000 to 1.

GRAND PRIZE DRAWING: The Grand Prize drawing for the Raffle will be held on Thursday October 19th, 2017 at The Homecoming Game located at Dutch Clark Stadium at Halftime at approximately 8PM. Ticket order request by mail must be received by 5pm on October 18th. Tickets may be purchased at the homecoming game until approximately 7:30pm or the start of the 2nd quarter. This date and all other dates stated in these Rules may be extended at the absolute discretion of the PTSA after notification and approval by the Colorado Secretary of State. The winning ticket will be drawn at random from a drum containing all eligible Raffle tickets. The drawing for the prize is open to the public; however, the winner does not need to be present to win.

GRAND PRIZE: The Grand Prize is either a 2017 Chevy Camaro or 2017 Chevy Colorado with a maximum MSRP of \$30,000 or a cash payout of \$20,000. This cash prize is also subject to all local, state and federal taxes. Vehicle will be purchased from Spradley Auto Group in Pueblo Colorado by the PTSA. Depictions of the Vehicle shown in informational materials, on the Centennial Band website, and elsewhere may only be representative of the Grand Prize; the actual Vehicle may be viewed at Spradley Chevy as well as at various marching band events during the year. The vehicles shown in photos are only representative of the make and models available for selection as the Grand Prize. Winner of the Vehicle must take delivery within the State of Colorado. Any expense for travel to Colorado to accept delivery shall be the sole responsibility of the winner. The Vehicle will be transferred to the Grand Prize winner in "AS IS, WHERE IS" condition. Vehicle is a new vehicle; however, it may have a nominal amount of miles due to the PTSA driving it to various marching band events during the year for purposes of promoting the Raffle. The Centennial Band Boosters, Centennial PTSA and Centennial High School Band do not provide any guarantee or warranty, expressed or implied, in connection with the Vehicle. PTSA and band accept no liability or responsibility regarding the manufacturing or

condition of the Vehicle. No warranties express or implied, of any type or nature are made or offered by PTSA or Centennial High School Band.

ALTERNATE GRAND PRIZE: The Grand Prize winner may choose to receive a check for the cash sum of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) in lieu of accepting the Vehicle as the grand prize. This cash prize is also subject to all local, state and federal taxes. Cutoff for purchases: Ticket order request by mail must be received by 5pm on October 18th.. Tickets may be purchased in person, including at the Centennial High School Homecoming Game until 7:30PM MDT, October 19th, 2017. As noted above, a limited number of tickets will be sold for the Raffle. Therefore, all tickets may sell out before the day of the Grand Prize drawing. Substitute Grand Prize in event of non-sellout of tickets: If fewer than 3000 Raffle tickets are sold, the PTSA reserves the right, in its absolute discretion, to substitute 50% of the gross sales revenue from the tickets sold as of the time of the entry deadline as the Grand Prize in lieu of the Vehicle. In the event that the PTSA exercises its right to award 50% of gross sales revenue from tickets sold in lieu of the Vehicle, no additional cash or prizes will be provided to the Grand Prize winner.

EARLY BIRD DRAWING: In addition to the Grand Prize Drawing, the Raffle will include one (1) Early Bird Drawing to be held on September 15th, 2017 at the Bell Game at Dutch Clark Stadium at Halftime. The winning tickets will be drawn at random from a drum containing all eligible tickets purchased and accepted up to the following cutoffs. Ticket requests by mail must be received by 5 PM MDT the day prior to the Early Bird Drawing to be eligible. Tickets may be purchased in person the day of up to the time of the Early Bird Drawing. The winning ticket will be returned to the drum so that Early Bird Drawing winner will continue to be eligible for all subsequent drawings (Grand Prize). For the Early Bird Drawing, the winner will receive a check for the cash sum of five hundred dollars (\$500). The Early Bird Drawing will be open to the public; however, the winner need not be present to win.

TAXES AND OTHER COST OF OWNERSHIP: Centennial PTSA does not undertake to give advice on the legal or tax consequences of the Raffle to the winner. However, PTSA understands the IRS' position is that amounts paid for chances in raffles, lotteries or similar drawings for valuable prizes are not donations, and consequently do not qualify as deductible charitable contributions. The Raffle winners assume and must pay all applicable fees and charges (including, but not limited to, tags and license) and income taxes (local, state and federal taxes) when the car and/or cash prize is transferred to them. Raffle winners agree to remit payment to the PTSA for any required income tax withholding. In addition, all costs of ownership of the Vehicle, including, but not limited to, insurance, are the sole responsibility of the Grand Prize winner. The PTSA assumes no responsibility for a prize winner's tax obligations. **THE GRAND PRIZE WINNER IS STRONGLY ENCOURAGED TO SEEK PROFESSIONAL LEGAL AND/OR TAX ADVICE. ACCEPTANCE OF THE GRAND PRIZE COULD HAVE MATERIAL CONSEQUENCES ON THE GRAND PRIZE WINNER INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, GOVERNMENT ENTITLEMENTS OR OTHER BENEFITS, OR OTHER LEGAL, FINANCIAL OR OTHER MATTERS.** Form W-2G will be filed with the Internal Revenue

Service as required to report the value of the prize(s) won. All required forms will also be filed with the Colorado Department of Revenue and Secretary of State. The winner will receive a copy of all forms filed with the respective authorities. This offer is void where prohibited by law and all federal, state and local laws and regulations apply.

OTHER PROVISIONS: By participating, you agree that all ticket purchasers and the person named on each Raffle ticket accept and agree (1) to be bound by all the rules, limitations and restrictions set forth herein, and (2) that their names and/or likenesses may be disclosed to and used by the news media and may otherwise be used by the PTSA, for publicity purposes and naming of the prize winners to be published in area newspapers or other media including television, radio, web and print. Winners agree to sign a publicity release without any further compensation. The Grand Prize winner will be published on the Band's website and facebook page www.centennialband.us. Names of the winners may be obtained by sending a written request plus a self-addressed, stamped envelope to Centennial PTSA 2525 Mountview Dr, Pueblo, CO 81008. The PTSA's interpretation and application of the rules and regulations shall be final. Additionally, all participants release Centennial Band Boosters, Centennial PTSA, Centennial Band and each of their respective directors, officers, contractors and agents from any and all liability for injuries, losses or damages of any kind caused by any prize or resulting from acceptance, possession, use or misuse of any prize. Each winner agrees to indemnify and hold Centennial Band Boosters, Centennial PTSA and Centennial High School Band and each of their respective directors, officers, contractors and agents harmless from any and all losses, damages, costs, expenses, rights, claims and actions of any kind arising in connection with or as a result of the winner's acceptance or use of any prize.

ELIGIBILITY: Raffle ticket purchasers and the person named on a raffle ticket must be at least 18 years of age at the time of purchase. Raffle tickets may not be purchased in the name of a business, trust, corporation, or other entity, or wherever prohibited by applicable law. Members of the official Raffle sub-committee are not eligible to win any prize in the Raffle. Prizewinners may be required to sign an affidavit of eligibility. Offer void where prohibited by law.

TICKETS: Tickets may be purchased in person by cash, check, or by mail with a check. You have not entered the Raffle until your entry submission, with full payment has been accepted by the PTSA. All entries must be fully completed in order to be eligible including the printed name, address, phone number, and email of the entrant. Acceptance of your entry submission will be communicated to you by delivery of a ticket stub or by written confirmation via e-mail from the PTSA. If a submission is accepted it will be deemed to have been accepted on the date and time on which the submission was received by the PTSA regardless of the date that the PTSA notifies you of the acceptance of your submission. You may buy as many tickets as you wish, subject to availability, until all 5,000 tickets have been sold. Each Raffle ticket will be entered separately in the drawing. Each Raffle ticket is a separate and equal chance to win any of the prizes offered. To order tickets by mail, use a ticket request form, which can be downloaded from www.centennialband.us. Send completed forms with payment by check or Money Order made out to "Centennial PTSA Band Car Raffle" % 2525 Mountview Dr Pueblo CO 81008.

When a Raffle ticket order is placed by mail and funds have cleared, the PTSA will complete the raffle ticket for the purchaser by filling in the name, address, email address and phone number. The PTSA will then place each completed raffle ticket stub in the secured raffle barrel and mail the ticket(s) to the purchaser. The purchaser may choose to receive an email from the PTSA confirming the ticket purchase and providing the ticket number(s) in lieu of receiving the physical ticket. If for any reason a check does not clear the purchaser's bank, the ticket purchase is null and void. Additionally, all defective or physically altered request forms are subject to disqualification at the discretion of the PTSA. Prior to the prize drawings, the PTSA will make a reasonable effort to notify any individual who submits such an entry form, or one which has been rejected because the funds did not clear, that the entry has been rejected. Any cure to the problem shall be considered a new order and processed in the order received. All requests for tickets for the drawing must be received and/or purchased by the indicated deadline(s).

REFUNDS: All Raffle ticket sales are final. No refunds will be made except that any ticket request with verified payment received after 5,000 tickets have been sold or after the Grand Prize Drawing deadlines set forth herein will be returned or destroyed with notice to the purchaser. No other refunds are available. The PTSA assumes no responsibility for lost, late, misdirected or non-delivered mail or any other failure to receive orders or deliver receipts prior to the drawing deadlines. A Raffle participant's sole and exclusive remedy for a breach by the PTSA shall be limited to the return of the purchase price paid for his or her Raffle ticket(s). In no event shall the Boosters, PTSA, Band or Centennial High School or their respective directors, officers, contractors, members, committee members, agents, advisors, or representatives be liable to any party for any loss or injuries to earnings, profits or goodwill, or for any incidental, special, punitive or consequential damages of any person or entity.

NOTIFICATION AND CLAIMING OF PRIZES: If the winner is not present at any of the drawings, the PTSA shall notify the winner by telephone and certified mail within thirty (30) days of the drawing. Grand Prize winner will also be posted on the band website. The winner must claim the prize within sixty (60) days of the drawing. The winner will need to provide proper identification to the satisfaction of the Games Manager. If a winner does not wish to claim the prize but wishes to donate it to the PTSA, the winner shall provide a written and notarized statement within the sixty (60) day period stating that the winner wishes to donate the prize to the PTSA. A prize winner shall not donate the prize back to the PTSA if doing so would violate Colorado state law. If a Raffle winner does not claim the prize or donate it to the organization within sixty (60) days of the original drawing, the organization shall notify the Secretary of State's office and may retain the prize or offer it in another raffle. The PTSA reserves the right to cancel this Raffle contest at any time after notification and approval from Colorado Secretary of State, in which event liability is limited to the refund of the ticket price to all participants. This Raffle is conducted for the benefit of the Centennial High School Band by Centennial High School PTSA, licensed by the Colorado Secretary of State, Bingo License No. 2017-11755. The raffles sponsor is solely responsible for the awarding and providing of any prizes.
